Item	Description
Personnel	
Salary, Benefits, Add'l Comp	Identifies who pays for Personnel compensation including salary, benefits, bonus, other additional compensation and payroll taxes.
Travel	Identifies who pays for Personnel travel subject to Exhibit 4 .
Training	Identifies who pays for Personnel training.
Relocation	Identifies who pays for transitioned Personnel relocation expenses.
Inflation/Deflation	Identifies who pays for inflation/deflation that impacts Personnel-related line items.
Increase / Decrease in Staffing	Identifies who pay for staffing increases and if staffing goes down, which Party gets the benefit.
Retention Payments	Identifies why pays Personnel retention payments if applicable.
EUC Devices	Identifies w pays for Laptop, Desktop, Printers, Mobile Phones, etc.
Office Space	Identifies who pays for employees office space.

Refresh Cycle	Identifies the maximum number of years before Equipment is refreshed.
Ownership of Equipment for Upgrades / Enhancements	Identifies who pays if Equipment needs to be upgraded or enhanced.
Ownership of Equipment Required to Support Growth	Identifies who pays if additional Equipment is required as the result of growth.
Maintenance	Identifies who pays for Equipment break/fix and preventative maintenance.

Item	Description
Software Currency	Identifies the version of Software as designated by DIR and DCS as current. See Exhibit 1 for definition of N/N-1. Financial responsibility determined in accordance with Software Releases/Upgrades/Enhancements.
Releases / Upgrades	Identifies who pays for Software upgrades. Financial responsibility includes N-1 to N upgrades where required, based upon Application requirements.
Software Required to Support Growth	Identifies who pays if new Software or additional licenses are required due to growth.
Charging Mechanism	Identifies who pays if new Software or additional licenses are required due to growth.
Facilities	
Current Assets	Identifies who pays for the current Facilities (building leases, HVAC, common services, etc.) that are used to provide the Services.
Refresh	Identify who pays for the upgrading and/or replacing of Equipment during the Term.
Upgrades / Enhancements	If upgrades or enhancements are needed for the Facility, identifies who pays for it.
Growth	If more space is needed, identifies who pays for the additional space.
